ORDINANCE NO. 26-13

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 1, ADDING CHAPTER 37 BUDGET OFFICER
OF THE FOREST VIEW VILLAGE CODE**

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BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Forest View, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. Amendment. Title 1 Chapter 37 of the Forest View Village Code is added as the following:

CHAPTER 37 BUDGET OFFICER

37.1: ADOPTION OF BUDGET ACT; BUDGET OFFICER

- (A) Budget Adopted:** The village prepares each year a budget in accordance with 65 Illinois Compiled Statutes 5/8-2-9.1 et seq., which has been specifically adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the village board.
- (B) Budget Officer; Position Created:** There is hereby created the position of budget officer, and the Village Administrator shall serve as budget officer, appointed by the village president with the advice and consent of the board of trustees.
- (C) Powers And Duties Of The Budget Officer:** The budget officer shall have the following powers and duties:
1. To permit, encourage, and establish the efficient planning, budgeting, auditing, reporting, accounting, and other fiscal management procedures in all municipal departments, commissions and boards.
 2. To compile an annual budget in accordance with subsection D of this section.
 3. Examine all books and records of all village departments, commissions and boards which relate to monies received and paid out by the village, its departments, commissions and boards, and debts and accounts receivable, amounts owed by or to the village, its departments, commissions and boards.
 4. To obtain such additional information from the village, its departments, commissions and boards as may be useful for purposes of compiling a village budget. Such information shall be furnished by the village, its departments, commissions and boards in the form required by the budget officer.
 5. To establish and maintain such procedures as shall ensure that no expenditures are

made by the village, its departments, commissions or boards except as authorized by the budget.

- (D) Budget Compilation:** The budget officer shall compile a budget which contains estimates of revenues available to the village for the fiscal year for which the budget is drafted, together with recommended expenditures for the village and all of its departments, boards and commissions. Revenue estimates and expenditure recommendations shall be presented in a manner which is in conformity with good fiscal management practices. The budget shall contain actual or estimated revenues and expenditures for the two (2) years immediately preceding the fiscal year for which the budget is prepared.
- (E) Budget In Lieu Of Appropriation Ordinance:** Passage of the annual budget by the corporate authorities shall be in lieu of passage of the appropriation ordinance as required by 65 Illinois Compiled Statutes 5/8-2-9 et seq. The annual budget shall be adopted by the corporate authorities before the beginning of the fiscal year to which it applies.
- (F) Public Inspection:** The village president and board of trustees of the village shall make the tentative annual budget available for public inspection for at least ten (10) days prior to the passage of the annual budget by publication in the journal of the proceedings of the corporate authorities or in such other form as the village president and board of trustees of the village may prescribe.
- (G) Public Hearing:** Not less than one week after the publication of the tentative budget and prior to final action on the budget, the corporate authorities shall hold at least one public hearing on the tentative annual budget, after which hearing or hearings the tentative annual budget may be further revised and passed without any further inspection, notice or hearing. Notice of the hearing shall be given by publication in a newspaper having general circulation in the village at least one week prior to the time of the hearing.

SECTION 3: Home Rule. This ordinance and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such ordinance should (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the corporate authorities of the Village of Forest View that to the extent of the terms of this ordinance should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, that this ordinance shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

SECTION 4: Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect starting the fiscal year after its adoption and approval in the manner provided by law.
