# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6-5-34 OF THE FOREST VIEW VILLAGE CODE TO PROHIBIT ELECTRIC BICYCLES AND ELECTRIC SCOOTERS IN THE FOREST VIEW VILLAGE PARK

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Forest View, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1. Amendment.** Section 6-5-34(A) of the Forest View Village Code is hereby amended to provide as follows [new language **underscored and bold**]:

### **Chapter 11. Electric Bicycles and Electric Scooters.**

6-5-34: CERTAIN ACTIVITIES AND/OR ITEMS PROHIBITED IN VILLAGE PARK:

- (A) The following activities and/or items are prohibited in the village park except when such activities are conducted in conjunction with an event sponsored by the Village of Forest View or the Forest View park district [New language in bold underlined]:
  - 1. Bicycles.
  - 2. Skateboards.
  - 3. Rollerblades.
  - 4. Food.
  - 5. Pets.
  - 6. Smoking.
  - 7. Electric Bicycles.
  - 8. Electric Scooters.

**SECTION 4: Home Rule.** This ordinance and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such ordinance should (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b)

legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the corporate authorities of the Village of Forest View that to the extent of the terms of this ordinance should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, that this ordinance shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

SECTION 5: Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and approval in the manner provided by law.
