**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A LEASE-PURCHASE AGREEMENT
IN CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF FIRE EQUIPMENT
(FOUTS FB-94 CUSTOM FIRE PUMPER)**

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IN CONNECTION WITH THE PURCHASE OF FIRE EQUIPMENT
(FOUTS FB-94 CUSTOM FIRE PUMPER)**

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have previously approved the purchase of “Equipment” (a Fouts FB-94 Custom Fire Pumper) from Fire Service, Inc. of St. John, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Village has received a proposal from Leasing 2, Inc. to enter into a Lease-Purchase Agreement in connection with the acquisition of the Equipment; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have determined that a general governmental need exists for the acquisition of the Equipment ; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have further determined that the Equipment will be used solely for essential governmental functions and not for private business use; and

WHEREAS, the Village has taken all necessary steps to authorize the acquisition of the Equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF FOREST VIEW AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Approval. The Lease-Purchase Agreement with Leasing 2, Inc. attached to this Resolution as Exhibit 1, for the lease-purchase of the Equipment over a term of 10 years,

is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: Authorization. The Village President is hereby authorized and directed to execute all documents necessary to effectuate the Lease-Purchase of the Equipment.

SECTION 3: Home Rule. This resolution and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such resolution should (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the corporate authorities of the Village of Forest View that to the extent of the terms of this resolution should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, that this resolution shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

SECTION 4: Effective Date. This Resolution is in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
