WHEREAS, the Village has over \$700,000 in outstanding fines and fees; and

WHEREAS ,the Village has received a proposal from A.R.M. for collection services at a rate lower than current vender and other vendors solicited; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have determined that a contract with A.R.M Associates is in the best financial interest of the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF FOREST VIEW AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Approval. The Village President and Board of Trustees approve starting the process to switch collection agencies to A.R.M. and Associates.

SECTION 2: Authorization. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute, finalize, negotiate, and approve all documents necessary to switch collection agencies to A.R.M. and Associates.

SECTION 3: Home Rule. This resolution and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such resolution should (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the corporate authorities of the Village of Forest View that to the extent of the terms of

this resolution should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, that this resolution shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

SECTION 4: Effective Date. This Resolution is in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
