Agenda Item # 1- Letter from Administrator Dropka requesting the Board to approve amending Section 10-2-14 relative to garages and accessory buildings. This is an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance No. 22-21, and under Section 10-17-1 of the Zoning Ordinance, as required by Illinois State law, an amendment to the Zoning Ordinance can be adopted by the Village Board only after a public hearing is held. Section 10-17-3 requires that there be notice of the public hearing which has to be published at least 15 days in advance of the hearing.
