**ORDINANCE NO. 26-11**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN SURPLUS  
PERSONAL PROPERTY**

**WHEREAS**, in the opinion of the President and Board of Trustees, the following described personal property is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of, the Village of Forest View:

Squad Car #1 (VIN: 1FM5K8AB0NGC43297), a 2022 Ford Police Interceptor

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF FOREST VIEW, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS IN THE EXERCISE OF THE VILLAGE'S HOME RULE POWERS, as follows:**

**SECTION 1:** That the above-described personal property is declared as surplus and the Village Administrator are hereby directed to dispose of said personal property. It is expressly understood that the vehicle is totaled and the title will be transferred to the liable insurance company as part of the claims processes.

**SECTION 2:** This ordinance and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such ordinance should (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state

law. It is the intent of the corporate authorities of the Village of Forest View that to the extent that the terms of this ordinance should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, that this ordinance shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
