VILLAGE OF FOREST VIEW

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WHEREAS, the Village currently uses an outdated payroll system; and

WHEREAS, the continual changes to State and Federal law require additional administrative tracking and calculations that are beyond the current systems capabilities;

WHEREAS, the Village has received a proposal from Paylocity to administer the payroll for the Village; and

WHEREAS, Paylocity has extensive experience in municipal operations which have unique characteristics under Fair Labor Standards Act and under the provisions of its collective bargaining agreements; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have determined that a contract with Paylocity is in the best financial interest of the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF FOREST VIEW AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Approval. The Village President and Board of Trustees approve starting the process to switch payroll systems to Paylocity.

SECTION 2: Authorization. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute, finalize, negotiate, and approve all documents necessary to switch the payroll system

to Paylocity.

SECTION 3: Home Rule. This resolution and each of its terms shall be the effective legislative act of a home rule municipality without regard to whether such resolution should (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law, or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the corporate authorities of the Village of Forest View that to the extent of the terms of this resolution should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, that this resolution shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

SECTION 4: Effective Date. This Resolution is in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
